COMMUTE OPTIONS

BUS AND RAIL

Trip planners, route maps, timetables and real-time location information make it easier to ride the bus and train.

CARPPOOL

RideshareOnline.com will connect you with neighbors who commute downtown so you can carpool or vanpool.

STAR PROGRAM

Join the STAR Carpool program and get premium parking and other incentives.

BIKE

From parking stations to “bike buddy” mentors, Seattle offers services to every level of bicycle rider.

WALK

Find walking routes, maps and more.

VANPOOL

Join a vanpool or form your own. One low fee covers the van, maintenance, fuel and insurance.

VANSHARE

Metro Vanshare provides commuter groups of five or more with a van and reserved parking to connect from home to transit or from transit to work.

ZIPCAR

Need a car for errands or meetings? Zipcars are located within a block or two of most downtown buildings and are available by the hour or by the day. Gas and insurance are included.

King County Metro Vanpools take over 7,000 cars off the road each day.

A single commuter taking public transit to work instead of driving can reduce CO2 by 4,800 pounds a year.

PARKING

Get all the information you need on parking locations, prices and reserved carpool spots.

PROMOTIONS

Find out about great incentives for driving less, such as cash giveaways and retail discounts.

FLEXPASS

Ride the bus, commuter rail or street car free with your employer-provided FlexPass. Also receive subsidies for vanpool and vanshipare.

Figure out how much time it takes you to walk or bike to your downtown destination using the following guides:

5 minutes by FOOT

5 minutes by BIKE

When it comes to commuting, a bus carrying only seven passengers is more fuel efficient than the average car transporting just a driver.

A typical commuter who switches from driving alone to using commute alternatives saves more than \$800 a year in transportation expenses.

It takes about 5 minutes to walk 0.25 miles. Walking to and from the bus, work, or other local destinations helps meet the recommended goal of moderate physical activity for a minimum of 30 minutes a day.

Each Zipcar takes as many as 15 cars off the road. Zipcar members report saving an average of \$436 per month on commuting expenses.

Seattle has the third highest percentage of bicycle commuters among the 50 biggest cities in the U.S. Why don't you join in!
