## Commuter Alert!

Attention Commuters! I-90 construction begins Sunday, July 5th at 4pm.

Westbound traffic over Lake Washington will be affected for 2 weeks as WSDOT crews replace the floating bridge's expansion joints.

I-90 construction closures include:

- Today - Thursday, July 2: Two westbound lanes closed from 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m. nightly on the floating bridge for construction prep work.
- Today - Thursday, July 2: I-90 express lanes closed 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. for construction prep. From 3 - 10 p.m. daily, crews also will close the northernmost lane of the I-90 express lanes near East Mercer Way on Mercer Island. The lane is the far left lane when traffic is heading eastbound.
- **Sunday, July 5: The I-90 express lanes will be completely closed almost all day. At 4 p.m., just one lane will be open on westbound mainline I-90 from Bellevue to Seattle.**
- Monday, July 6: by 5 a.m., the mainline lanes of westbound I-90 will be completely closed and all westbound traffic will be funneled into the two express lanes.
