In 2016, at a time when many small businesses were not yet offering ORCA benefits, Elliott Bay began providing transit passes to their employees through ORCA Passport. The company continues to provide this benefit to all 32 of their staff.



The Motivation - Why ORCA?

In 2010, Elliott Bay Book Company moved to Capitol Hill from Pioneer Square. At the time, many of the staff lived in the Capitol Hill neighborhood, and were excited to work in the same neighborhood that they lived in.

Six years later, the cost of living in the neighborhood had increased dramatically. brêd

Many staff had to move to more

affordable areas, and were faced with a longer, more expensive commute.

Many employees were already commuting by bus, or the newly opened Capitol Hill Light Rail station, since parking around the store was limited. The company polled staff to gauge interest, and nearly everyone wanted to move forward with a transit benefit. In 2016, the company started an ORCA Passport program providing a mostly employer-subsidized transit pass to all employees.

"The affordability factor for living in the neighborhood and working here have changed dramatically."

- Offering ORCA reduces the financial burden of taking transit for work, errands, and leisure. An individual monthly bus pass costs at least \$1,200 out of pocket. An employer-provided pass through ORCA Passport costs \$155 - \$388 per year, as of May 2023.
