About

Mission Statement: Foss Home and Village is a not-for-profit, mission-driven, experienced service provider that promotes excellent healthcare, quality of life, dignity, and respect for our seniors.

Foss was founded in 1929 and is a community-nourishing assisted living home in the neighbourhood. By prioritizing hiring in nearby communities, and providing housing for some employees, Foss has achieved a remarkable rate of employees walking and carpooling to work.

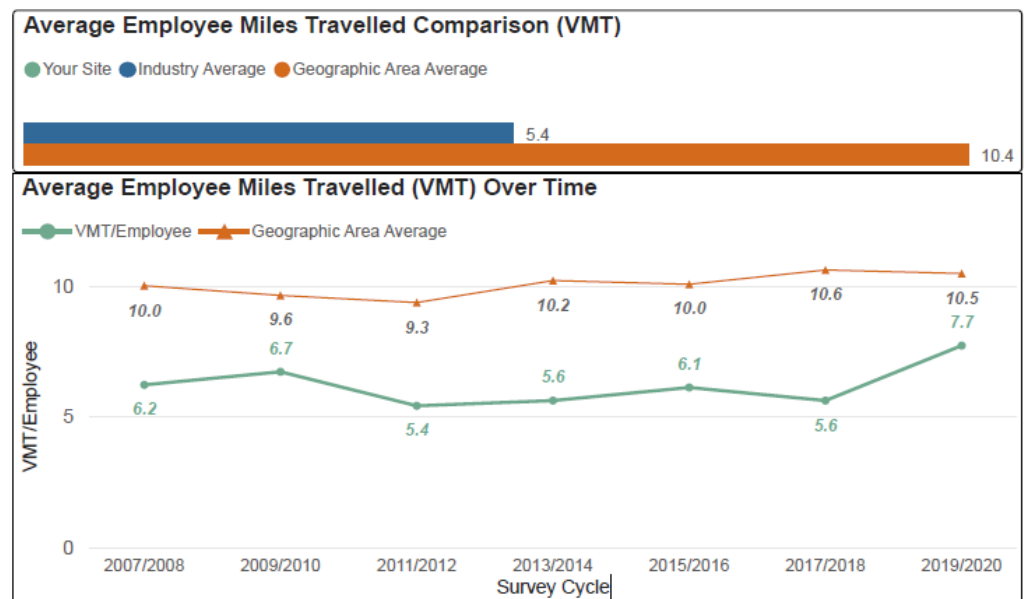

Foss employees are essential workers and do not have the luxury to telework. Close to 60% of the employees live close to the worksite (5-mile radius), and Foss highly encourages the employees to bike, walk, or actively commute to the worksite.

Commute Trends

According to our 2022 Commute Survey, about 10% of Foss employees walk to work and 11% of employees carpool to work. Overall, about 30% of employees choose climate friendly commute modes to get to work.

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A Focus on Community

59% of Foss employees live within a 5-mile radius.

40% of employees live in the same zipcode as their workplace.

Foss embraces community hiring practices actively collaborates with two nearby community colleges to recruit nurses.

Foss organizes engaging events such as community fairs and farmers markets. These events fosters a sense of community and serve as a platform for identifying local talents.
